

We have asked 300 Nerds about their personal preferences, routine and life history. Guess one of their 8 most common answers, without bumping into the most common one to prove you understand nerdiness beyond the stereotypes!

**Components and setup:**

**1. 100 double-sided scoring sheets**

Give 1 to each player.

Each round you'll write your guess in these fields

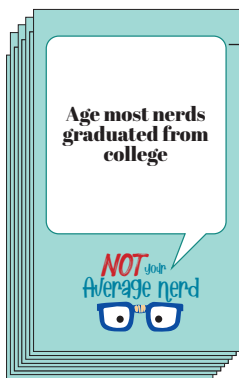

On rounds 4 to 6, your score is multiplied!

Add up your scores to see your total scores

**2. 120 cards with questions about nerds**

Shuffle them, take 6 at random and create a deck without revealing the answers. You will play with them in this game.



1	Six	11%
2	Five, Seven, Eight	9%
5	Four, Nine	8%
7	Two	7%
8	Three	6%

Front side: questions answered by 300 nerds

Back side: 8 most common answers (and even though nerds are usually very intelligent, the back of this card does not match the front of the card next to it)

This number is the percentage of nerds who had this answer

**Playing the game:**

1. Take a card from the deck, showing its question.
2. All players write a guess simultaneously in their scoring sheets. Try to guess one of the 8 most common answers, but take care not to write down the top 1!
3. If you wrote down answers 2 to 8, your score is the percentage number shown in the right of the card.
4. **If you wrote down the top 1 answer, or an answer that is not in the card, your score is zero.**
5. On rounds 4 and 5, multiply your score by 2. On round 6, multiply it by 3.
6. After 6 rounds, the game is over. Add up your scores from all rounds to determine the **Supreme Nerd!**

**!** The answers given by nerds were not changed. Some of them may reflect common misconceptions people have. For example, if some nerds consider mutts to be a valid dog breed, it would not be invalidated.
