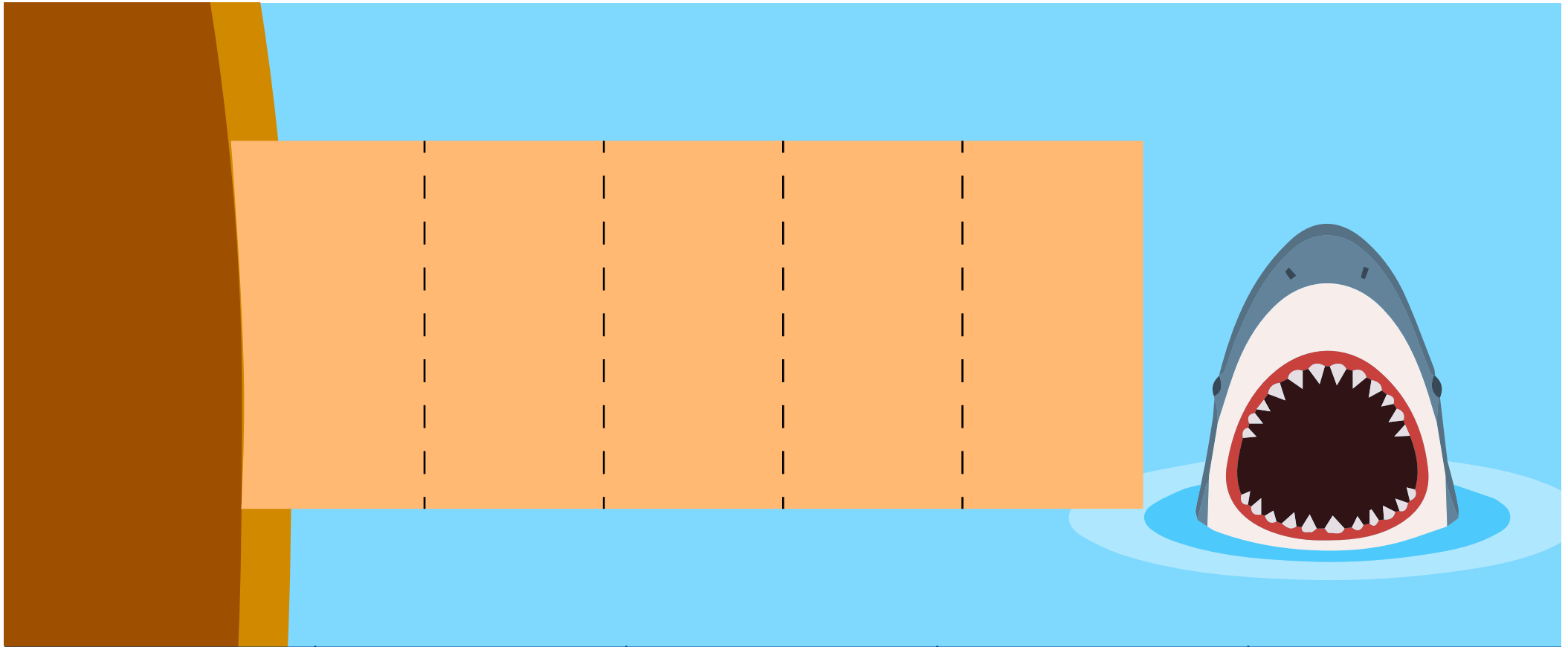




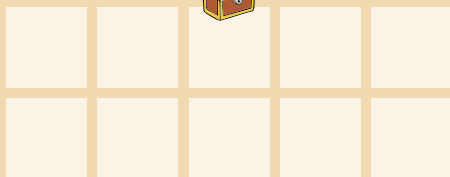

If you have the top answer, you can push someone twice.

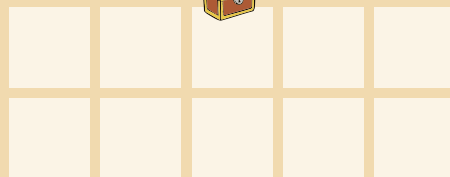


Brute McGill

Push 1x all players that are in your plank space

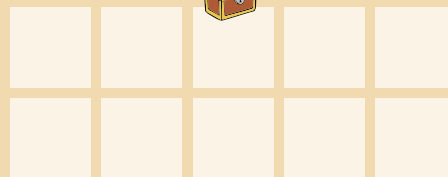


Lone Lenny

If you are alone in a plank space, you may retreat to the boat.

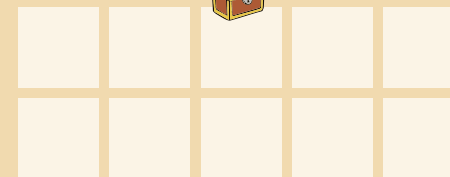


Margot, the Braggart



On your turn:

If you got the top or 2nd answer, get 1 more gold. If not, walk 1 more space on the plank.

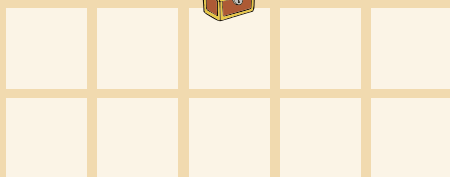


Mercedes, the Captain's daughter



On your turn:

If you have the last answer, choose another player to advance 2x in your place.

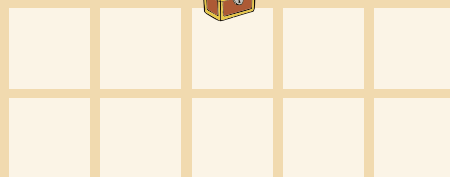


Assassin Cindy



Round end:

Lay flat all pawns on your plank space. If a pawn in your space is already laid, it dies.

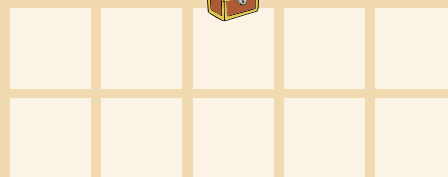


Friendly Pete



On your turn:

If you walk on the plank, you may bring players on the same plank space with you.



Cowardly Maureen



Round start:

You can declare you won't choose a letter to retreat 3x in the plank



Crooked Cate



On your turn:

If you have the right answer, steal the 2 gold you'd get from 2 different players.



Scarlett Gold digger



Round end:

If you're on the same plank space as the player who won the game, you win instead.



Fat Joe



Other players' turns:

No one can occupy the same plank space as you. If they do, bump them to the more advanced space in the plank



Greedy Jane



Other players' turns:

Any pirate more advanced in the plank than you cannot gain gold.



Suicide Sue



On your turn:

You win if you fall from the plank. You're out if you gain 3 gold or more.



Sticky-fingered Johr



Round end:

Steal 1 gold from one player in the same plank space as you.



Dumb Rick



On your turn:

If you have the bottom answer, gain 2 gold and don't walk on the plank. For all others, walk once on the plank and gain no gold.



Furtive Flynn



On your turn:

Discard 1 gold from all players that are on the boat.



Captain Cornelius



Select phase:

You may select 2 answers if you want.



Smith, the Kiss-ass



On your turn:

Instead of revealing your answer, you may declare you have the same answer as a player who didn't reveal theirs yet.



Polly, the Parrot



On your turn:

If you fall from the plank, fly back to the boat and steal 1 gold from all players there.



Copycat Maude



On your turn:

Pay 1 gold to a previous player to copy his answer instead of revealing yours.
